AGREED MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINES

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and the Stanley Lake Municipal Utility District (Applicant) respectfully request an extension of the deadlines provided in Order No. 4. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On August 3, 2018, Order No. 4 was issued and deemed the application of Stanley Lake Municipal Utility District to Amend Certificates of Convenience and Necessity and to Decertify portions of SC Utilities and T&W Water Service Company's Certificated Service areas in Montgomery County to be administratively complete. Furthermore, the order provided a procedural schedule which required applicant to file with the Commission signed consent forms by September 18, 2018. The applicant filed the consent forms for Stanley Lake Municipal Utility District and T&W Water Service Company on September 18, 2018. Applicant has been unable to secure the signed consent form for SC Utilities. Staff and applicant jointly request the following revised procedural schedule:

EVENT	DEADLINE
Deadline for Applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	October 18, 2018
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	November 1, 2018
deadline for parties to file a joint proposed notice of approval including detailed findings of fact, corresponding conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	November 8, 2018

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the adoption of the aforementioned revised procedural schedule.






