**ORDER NO. 2
ADDRESSING SUFFICIENCY OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice of Stanley Lake Municipal Utility District (Stanley Lake MUD). Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge find that the application is administratively complete. Commission Staff also recommended that the administrative law judge require Stanley Lake MUD to provide notice and file signed affidavits attesting that notice was issued, along with a copy of the actual notices, within 30 days of the date of notice and the last publication date. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.


The administrative law judge finds that the application is administratively complete and directs Stanley Lake MUD to provide notice of the application as described in Commission Staff's recommendation using the included forms. The proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:

Deadline for Stanley Lake MUD to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	June 25, 2018
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of the applicant filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
