COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this response to Order No. 2, Staff's Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On April 10, 2018, Stanley Lake MUD filed an application to amend Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) Nos. 11222 (water) and 20483 (sewer) and to decertify a portion of T&W Water Service's CCN No. 12892 and SC Utilities' CCN No. 20586 service area in Montgomery County. The requested area consists of approximately 739 total acres including nine (9) acres decertified from T&W Water Service and nine (9) acres decertified from SC Utilities, and six (6) current customers.

On May 21, 2018, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 2 establishing a deadline of June 25, 2018 for Stanley Lake MUD to file signed affidavits that notice was given, along with a copy of the notice sent to affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation. Order No. 2 also required Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice 10 days after the filing by Stanley Lake MUD. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. NOTICE

Stanley Lake MUD has not filed the signed affidavits that notice was given, along with a copy of the notice sent to affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation with the Central Records Division of the Public Utility Commission. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests to revise the procedural schedule to allow for such filing.

III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following amended procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Stanley Lake MUD to file with the Commission signed affidavits that notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	July 19, 2018
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within ten (10) days of Stanley Lake MUD filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	Thirty (30) days after notice is issued

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that the amended proposed procedural schedule be adopted.
