SECOND UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Second Unopposed Request for Extension of Time and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On April 18, 2018, Cyndie Park 2 Water Supply Corporation (Cyndie Park 2) and Nueces Water Supply Corporation (Nueces WSC) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Nueces County, Texas. Specifically, Cyndie Park 2 seeks to transfer its water service area and facilities under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12100 to Nueces WSC. The service area to be transferred includes 30.2 acres and 18 current customers. Order No. 5, issued September 28, 2018, granted Staff's unopposed request for an extension of time and adopted a revised procedural schedule setting October 12, 2018, as the new deadline for Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation for Applicants to proceed with the transaction. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. The transaction is contingent upon the construction of a distribution line and pump station improvements.¹ Nueces WSC has advised Staff that a letter from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality approving the plans for the pump station is forthcoming, but the letter has not yet been filed in the docket. Accordingly,

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Staff requests that its deadline to request a hearing or file a recommendation be extended to October 22, 2018. Staff has contacted counsel for Nueces WSC who stated that Nueces WSC is not opposed to the requested extension.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order granting its request and extending its deadline to request a hearing or file a recommendation to October 22, 2018.




