**ORDER NO. 7
APPROVING TRANSACTION TO PROCEED**

This Order addresses Cyndie Park 2 Water Supply Corporation and Nueces Water Supply Corporation's (collectively, applicants) application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Nueces County.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the transaction proposed in this application may proceed and be completed. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than 30 days after, applicants must file proof that the transaction has been consummated.

Applicants have 180 days to complete the transaction under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(n). If the transaction is not completed within this period, the approval is void, unless the Commission in writing extends the time period for good cause shown.¹ The ALJ notes, because Nueces has an outstanding violation with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), it is required to submit documentation from TCEQ confirming that the violation has been resolved at least 14 days before filing evidence that the sale has been completed.² Additionally, the ALJ notes there are no customer deposits held by Cyndie Park 2. Applicants are advised that the certificate affected by this application will continue to be held by Cyndie Park 2 until the application is complete in accordance with the Commission's rules and final approval is issued.

In an effort to finalize this case as soon as possible, beginning November 26, 2018, and continuing monthly thereafter, the applicants must file an update regarding the status of the efforts to conclude the transaction and submit documents evidencing the transaction has been completed.



Within 15 days following the filing of the applicants' proof that the transaction has been completed, Commission Staff is required to file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the documents and propose a schedule for the continued processing of this docket.
