**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVE INCOMPLETE;
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's May 18, 2018, recommendation that the application of Cyndie Park 2 Water Supply Corporation and Nueces Water Supply Corporation (collectively, applicants) is not administratively complete because it contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in the memorandum of Sherrie Keylon of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation division.


The administrative law judge finds the application is incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider applications filed until it has made a determination of administrative completeness; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before June 19, 2018, applicants shall supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Applicants shall not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before July 17, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
