# COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Recommendation in response to a Notice Setting Deadline for Staff's Recommendation and would show the following:

## I. BACKGROUND

On April 26, 2018, Winterhaven Homeowners Association, Inc. (Winterhaven) filed an application to implement a pass-through rate change for fees imposed on it by the North Harris County Regional Water Authority (NHCRWA). The NHCRWA charges a groundwater pumping fee for water pumped from wells. This fee increased from \$2.90 per 1,000 gallons to \$3.40 per 1,000 gallons, effective April 1, 2018.

On May 4, 2018, a Notice was issued establishing a deadline of May 25, 2018, for Staff to file a recommendation on Winterhaven's application and sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

#### II. RECOMMENDATION

As detailed in the attached memorandum from Kathryn Eiland in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff has reviewed Winterhaven's application and notice and recommends that both be deemed sufficient. Staff's review also indicates that the application and notice meet the requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.21 and demonstrate that Winterhaven has satisfied the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.21. Staff therefore recommends that Winterhaven's application be approved and that the attached tariff pages be provided to Winterhaven. Staff notes that Winterhaven also requested that the mailing address on its tariff be updated. The attached tariff pages contain the updated address requested by Winterhaven.

### III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that Winterhaven's application and notice be deemed sufficient, that Winterhaven's application be approved, and that Winterhaven be provided a copy of the attached tariff sheets.

Inc. for a Pass-Through Rate Change

On April 26, 2018, Winterhaven Homeowners Association, Inc. (Applicant), Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12648 filed an application to implement a pass-through rate change pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.21. The pass-through adjustment is for an increase in the water use fee billed by North Harris County Regional Water Authority (NHCRWA) to \$3.40 per 1,000 gallons effective April 1, 2018. The Applicant proposes charging only the exact fee charged by NHCRWA of \$3.40 per 1,000 gallons with no line loss. The current, approved tariff contains a \$25 flat fee per connection and the pass-through rate of \$2.90 only.

The Applicant requests a NHCRWA pass-through rate change from \$2.90 to \$3.40 per 1,000 gallons of groundwater pumped for the Winterhaven subdivision. The Applicant provided the following:

- 1. Documentation substantiating the NHCRWA fees of \$3.40 per 1,000 gallons;
- 2. Copies of two notices to customers, one including the pass through provision for the tariff, and one indicating the increase from \$2.90 to charge \$3.40 per 1,000 gallons for the increase in NHCRWA fees; and
- 3. Copy of the pages of its tariff that contain the rate that will change

The application did not identify the public water system (PWS) name and corresponding number issued by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ), however, the TCEQ Drinking Water Watch website indicates that the water system for Winterhaven Subdivision has PWS No. 1012015 in Harris County.

Staff recommends that the Commission deem the application sufficient for filing, approve the attached tariff, pass-through rates, and the pass-through provision as requested.
