PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO DECERTIFY A PORTION OF ITS CERVIFICATES OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

Notice is given to the public of the filing with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (commission) of an application to decertify a portion of a water and a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in El Paso County.

Docket Style and Number: Application of El Paso Water Utilities Public Service Board to Decertify a Portion of Its Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in El Paso County, Docket Number 48328.

The Application: On May 1, 2018, El Paso Water Utilities Public Service Board filed an application to decertify a portion of water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10211 and sewer CCN No. 21008 in El Paso County. A portion of the certificated area is not near any of EPWU's existing utility infrastructure and does not have utility service in such area. Therefore, EPWU is requesting to decertify a portion of area from its water and sewer CCN Nos in order for Horizon Regional Municipal District (HRMUD) to extend water and sewer services to such area. The total service area affected includes approximately 342 acres of the water service area and 487 acres of the sewer service area and 0 current customers.
