COMMISSION STAFF'S STATUS REPORT

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Status Report and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 3, 2018, Gum Island Utility Company (Gum Island) filed an application as "Whitewing" utility for a Class B rate change under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.1871 and 13.1872(c)(2). Order No. 6, issued August 8, 2018, found the application administratively complete, directed Gum Island to re-notice customers, and suspended the effective date of the proposed rate change for 265 days from the effective date included in the new notice to customers.

On September 20, 2019, Gum Island filed an application for a sale, transfer, or merger (STM).¹ On September 24, 2019, Gum Island filed a revised Notice of Proposed Rate Change with a proposed effective date of November 1, 2019. Order No. 12, issued November 5, 2019, suspended the new effective date until July 23, 2020, and established January 25, 2020, as the deadline for Staff to file an update on the status of the STM application and a recommendation on the further processing of this docket, including a procedural schedule.

Staff filed a status report on February 25, 2020, requesting the continued abatement of this proceeding. Order No. 15, issued February 27, 2020, continued the abatement and directed staff to file a Status Report by April 24, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STATUS REPORT

Gum Island's STM application was found sufficient on March 13, 2020,² and Gum Island filed proof of notice on April 1, 2020 and April 15, 2020.³ Staff's recommendation that Gum Island's proof of notice be found sufficient was filed contemporaneously with this Status Report. At this time, Staff recommends continuing the abatement of the instant case for an additional 60 days while Staff and Gum Island work on the continued processing of the STM application. Staff will file a Status Report on the progress of the STM on or before June 23, 2020.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order continuing the abatement of this case and directing Staff to file a status report on or before June 23, 2020.
