**ORDER NO. 14
FINDING MAPPING REVISIONS INSUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING
OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation, filed on August 25, 2020, concerning the sufficiency of the mapping revisions. Commission Staff recommended that the mapping revisions be found deficient for the reasons outlined in the August 25, 2020 memorandum of Alicia Maloy.

The administrative law judge finds the mapping revisions deficient and amends the procedural schedule as follows:
