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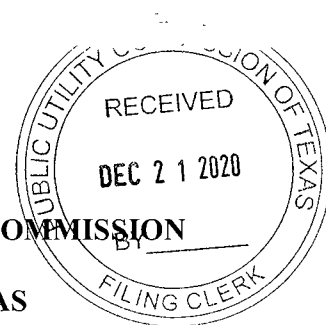

**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

**COMES NOW** the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Request for Extension. In support, Staff shows the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On May 8, 2018, the City of Dayton (Dayton) filed an application to obtain water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Liberty and Harris Counties under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.242 to 13.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 to 24.259.

On October 30, 2020, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 15, requiring Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of Dayton's supplemental mapping information by December 29, 2020. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**II. SUFFICIENCY OF MAPPING REVISIONS**

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff continues to work with Dayton to obtain the necessary materials to review the second supplement to the amended application filed by Dayton on November 30, 2020. For this reason, Staff requests that the deadline for its recommendation on the sufficiency of Dayton's supplemental mapping information be extended to January 14, 2021. Staff has conferred with counsel for Dayton who indicated that Dayton is unopposed to the requested extension.

**III. CONCLUSION**

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ grant an extension of time for Staff to file its recommendation on the sufficiency of Dayton's supplemental mapping information.
