



This Order addresses Commission Staff's February 5, 2021 recommendation on sufficiency of the revised mapping and digital data filed by the City of Dayton on November 30, 2020.

The administrative law judge finds the revised mapping and digital data filed by Dayton on November 30, 2020, deficient. On or before March 5, 2021, Dayton must file revised mapping and digital data addressing the discrepancies described in the February 5, 2021 memorandum of Alicia Maloy. On or before April 5, 2021, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
