### COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On May 8, 2018, the City of Dayton (Dayton) filed an application to obtain water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Liberty and Harris Counties under Texas Water Code (TWC) §§ 13.242 to 13.250 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.225 to 24.259.

On March 8, 2021, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 19, requiring Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of Dayton's supplemental mapping information by May 5, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

#### I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff continues to review the second supplemental materials filed by Dayton. For this reason, Staff requests that the deadline for its recommendation on the sufficiency of Dayton's supplemental mapping information be extended to May 19, 2021.

#### II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ grant an extension of time for Staff to file its recommendation on the sufficiency of Dayton's supplemental mapping information.
