ORDER NO. 21 FINDING MAPPING REVISIONS SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of mapping revisions filed on May 18, 2021. As detailed in the memorandum of Alicia Maloy of the Commission's Infrastructure Division, Commission Staff reviewed the application, along with the supplemental information filed on April 5, 2021, and recommended that the mapping revisions be deemed sufficient.

The administrative law judge finds the mapping revisions sufficient. The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicant	June 25, 2021
Deadline for applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	July 9, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	July 16, 2021
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	July 23, 2021
