CITY OF DAYTON'S NOTICE OF CONSENT

COMES NOW, the City of Dayton (the "City"), by and through its undersigned attorneys of record, and files this Notice of Consent, and, in support thereof, would respectfully show as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 8, 2018, the City filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission") its application to obtain water and sewer Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Liberty and Harris Counties. On May 19, 2021 the administrative law judge issued Order No. 21, finding mapping revisions sufficient and establishing a deadline of June 25, 2021 for Commission Staff to provide final maps and certificates to the City for consent and a deadline of July 9, 2021 for the City to file a signed Consent Form with the Commission. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. CONSENT
