EVIDENCE OF RECORDING

COMES NOW, the City of Dayton (City), by and through its undersigned attorneys of record, and files this Evidence of Recording. In support thereof, the City would respectfully show as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 8, 2018, the City filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (the Commission) the above-referenced petition for water and sewer Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Liberty County, Texas (the Application). A Notice of Approval was issued on August 19, 2021, and directed the City to: (1) comply with the recording requirements in Texas Water Code § 13.257(r) and (s); then (2) submit to the Commission evidence of such recording no later than Monday, October 4, 2021. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. EVIDENCE OF RECORDING

Pursuant to the Notice of Approval, the City hereby submits the evidence of recording attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as **Attachment A**, which contains the following documents recorded in the Official Public Records of Liberty County, Texas on September 16, 2021: (a) an Affidavit of Recording pursuant to Section 13.257 of the Texas Water Code; (b) a certified copy of water CCN No. 13297; (c) a certified copy of sewer CCN No. 21124; (d) a certified map depicting water CCN No. 13297; and (e) a certified map depicting sewer CCN No. 21124.

¹ Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 22.4, "[i]n computing any period of time prescribed . . . by order of the commission or any administrative law judge, . . . [t]he period shall conclude on the last day of the designated period unless that day is a day the commission is not open for business, in which event the designated period runs until the end of the next day on which the commission is open for business." The Notice of Approval directed the City to comply with the above-referenced recording requirements no later than 45 days after the date the Notice of Approval was issued. Forty-five days from August 19, 2021 is October 3, 2021. Because that day is a Sunday, the deadline is extended to the next day the commission is open for business; October 4, 2021.

AFFIDAVIT OF RECORDING PURSUANT TO SECTION 13.257 OF THE TEXAS WATER CODE

Maris M. Chambers, attorney for the City of Dayton, does hereby submit the following documents for recording in the real property records of Liberty County, Texas, as required by Texas Water Code § 13.257(r) and (s), which, in pertinent part, provide:

- (r) A utility service provider shall:
 - (1) record in real property records of each county in which the service area or a portion of the service area is located a certified copy of the map of the certificate of public convenience and necessity and of any amendment to the certificate as contained in the utility commission's records, and a boundary description as contained in the utility commission's records, and a boundary description of the service area by:
 - (A) a metes and bounds survey certified by a licensed state land surveyor or a registered professional land surveyor;
 - (B) the Texas State Plane Coordinate System;
 - (C) verifiable landmarks, including a road, creek, or railroad line; or
 - (D) if a recorded plat of the area exists, lot and block number; and
 - (2) submit to the utility commission evidence of the recording.
- (s) Each county shall accept and file in its real property records a utility service provider's map presented to the county clerk under this section if the map meets filing requirements, does not exceed 11 inches by 17 inches in size, and is accompanied by the appropriate fee.






