**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT, REGARDING,  
NOTICE, AND GRANTING WAIVER**

On May 14, 2018, Virgin Mobile USA, L.P. (Virgin Mobile) filed an application to amend its designations as an eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 26.418 and an eligible telecommunications provider (ETP) under 16 TAC § 26.417.

On May 22, 2018, Commission Staff concluded that Virgin Mobile's application is sufficient for further review, its proposed notice should be approved, and no notice beyond publication in the *Texas Register* is required. Commission Staff also stated it does not oppose Virgin Mobile's request for waiver of 16 TAC § 26.417(c)(1)(A) so that its ETP and ETC designations may be processed simultaneously.

Virgin Mobile filed an affidavit of proof of mailing on May 21, 2018.

In accordance with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application is sufficient for further review, no further notice is required, and Virgin Mobile's request for waiver is granted.
