Question:

Referring to page 24, lines 17-24, is ETI also proposing to update the annual number of customers and associated kWh sales and base revenues through June 2018? If not, please explain why.

Response:

ETI is not planning to update its number of customers associated kWh sales and base revenues through June 2018 in general. However, ETI is planning on adjusting the revenue requirement associated with the plant assets in the post test year plant addition adjustment in a manner similar to the distribution cost recovery rider rule that recognizes changes in sales volumes.

Addendum 1:

This response revises, corrects, and supersedes ETI's original response (shown above).

Please see the Company's response to OPUC 6-3. As noted in that response, ETI has not undertaken and does not propose to make any modification to the post-Test Year Adjustment that ETI has requested in this matter to update its number of customers, associated kWh sales, and/or base revenues for the period January through June 2018. In ETI's view, such an adjustment is inappropriate under the facts presented in ETI's case and applicable law. Nonetheless, the information would allow another party to calculate such a modification should it wish to do so.

ETI currently expects to provide the above-referenced data by July 25, 2018, as an addendum response to this request and/or OPUC 6-3.
