**E.I. DU PONT DE NEMOURS AND COMPANY'S NOTICE OF CONFIDENTIAL
FILING AND DESIGNATION OF INFORMATION AS
HIGHLY SENSITIVE PROTECTED MATERIALS**

E.I. du Pont de Nemours and Company ("DuPont"), submit this statement, pursuant to paragraph 4 of the Protective Order in this case, explaining that limited portions of Franklin Maduzia's testimony for DuPont will be filed as Highly Sensitive Protected Materials. Pages of Mr. Maduzia's testimony that contain HSPM will be submitted properly under P.U.C. Proc. R. 22.71(d) and a redacted version of the testimony will be filed electronically.

The small portions of the testimony that will be redacted are HSPM because they contain information regarding "business operations or financial information that is commercially sensitive." Further, this information is exempted from disclosure under the Texas Public Information Act, Tex. Gov't Code § 552.110(b), because its release would cause substantial competitive harm to DuPont.¹ DuPont's counsel has reviewed the information sufficiently and hereby states in good faith that the information is exempt from public disclosure under the Public Information Act and merits Highly Sensitive Protected Materials designation.


