ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVE INCOMPLETE;
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's June 20, 2018, recommendation that the application of Chuck Bell d/b/a Chuck Bell Water Systems, LLC and Undine Texas, LLC (collectively, applicants) for a sale, transfer or merger of facilities and certificate rights is not administratively complete. The application contains material deficiencies, as specifically described in the memorandum of Emily Sears and Gary Horton, Jr. of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation division and proposed deadlines for applicants to complete the application and for a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency.

The administrative law judge finds the application is incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider applications filed until it has made a determination of administrative completeness; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before July 20, 2018, applicants shall supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Applicants shall not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before August 20, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
