NOTICE SUFFICIENT; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE



Deadline for Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition	Seven days from the deadline for the City of Cut and Shoot and intervenors to file a response
Deadline for Stoecker to file a reply to the City of Cut and Shoot's response and Commission Staff's recommendation on final disposition	Seven days from the deadline for Commission Staff to file its final recommendation
Sixty day administrative approval	Sixty days from the Order deeming the petition administratively complete
