COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this response to Order No. 3, Staff's Recommendation on Sufficiency of Notice. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 31, 2018, Crest Water Company (Crest Water) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12037 in Johnson County. The total area being requested includes approximately 195 acres and zero current customers.

On August 31, 2018, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 3, establishing a deadline of October 11, 2018, for Crest Water to file signed affidavits that notice was given, along with a copy of the notice sent to affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation. Order No. 3 also required Staff to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice 10 days after the filing by Crest Water. Crest Water filed signed affidavits on September 14, 2018, and on September 17, 2018. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. NOTICE

Staff has reviewed the Applicant's proof of notice and found it to be insufficient. Crest Water has not filed a copy of the notice sent to affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation once each week for two consecutive weeks. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests to revise the procedural schedule to allow for such filing.

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III. PROPOSED AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following amended procedural schedule

Deadline for Crest Water to file with the Commission signed affidavits that notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	October 29, 2018
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on	Within ten (10) days of Crest Water
sufficiency of notice	filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	Thirty (30) days after notice is issued

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests that the amended proposed procedural schedule be adopted.
