COMMISSION STAFF'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and respectfully request an extension of the deadline provided in Order No. 2. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 31, 2018, James A. Dyche, d/b/a Crest Water Company (Crest) filed an application to amend its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12037 in Johnson County. The total area being requested includes approximately 195 acres and zero current customers.

On October 25, 2018, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 5, finding notice sufficient, and requiring Staff and Applicant to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law by January 18, 2019.

II. MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires more time to consult with Crest to arrive at agreed upon findings of fact and conclusions of law. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge extend the deadline for filing joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law to January 31, 2019.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above motion for extension.




