

Dear Ms. Reyes,

As requested, attached is the proof of notice for Docket No. 48409. The notice of application has been sent to all cities, districts, and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate boundaries or certified service area are located within two miles from the outer boundary of the requested area, and any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction that overlaps the requested area. Additionally, the county judge, each groundwater conservation district that is wholly or partially included in the requested area, and any customers or affected parties in the requested area have also been notified.

The original notice, included in Order No. 3, contained language that both water service area and water facilities are being transferred. However, in this transfer only the water service area is being transferred, no facilities are involved. The notice was altered to reflect only the transfer of water service area. This alteration was confirmed with staff by email on September 4th.

The notices were sent out by Green Valley Special Utility District on September 18, 2018. Attached to this letter are copies of the notice that was sent out along with a copy of the map showing the proposed service area that was included with each notice. The required completed original affidavit is also attached this letter.


