**ORDER NO. 1  
REQUIRING RESPONSES**

**I. Background**

On June 11, 2018, Nzinga Hughes filed a complaint against The Trails at Dominion Park, Ab-Go Trails at Dominion Park Propco, LLC, NWP Services Corporation, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 215, and Goldoller Real Estate Investments regarding water and wastewater method of billing and related charges. This complaint is filed under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.242 and is available on the Commission's Interchange at <http://interchange.puc.texas.gov>.

**II. Requiring Response**

Under 16 TAC § 22.78, The Trails at Dominion Park, Ab-Go Trails at Dominion Park Propco, LLC, NWP Services Corporation, Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 215, and Goldoller Real Estate Investments, and shall file a response to the complaint no later than July 2, 2018, addressing the following:

1. the Commission's jurisdiction over this proceeding;
2. allegations raised in the complaint;
3. applicable statutes, rules, orders, and tariff provisions;
4. copies of any rates or tariffs that are the subject of this complaint; and
5. any other matters relevant to the complaint.



### III. Statement of Position from Commission Staff

Commission Staff shall file a statement of position by July 9, 2018. As part of the statement of position, Commission Staff shall address whether Ms. Hughes complied with the requirements for informal resolution.<sup>1</sup>

### IV. Filings

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission filing clerk.<sup>2</sup> A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties.<sup>3</sup> All filings can be accessed on the Commission's Interchange.

### V. Ex Parte Communications


*Ex parte* communications with the administrative law judge are prohibited.<sup>4</sup> Parties shall communicate with the ALJ only through written documents filed with the Commission's Filing Clerk and served on all parties. Questions concerning this Order or any other order must be submitted in writing, filed with the Commission, and served on all parties of record.

### VI. Notifying Office of Public Utility Counsel

The Office of Public Utility Counsel is notified of this proceeding by copy of this Order.
