**SOAH ORDER NO. 6
GRANTING NZINGA HUGHES' MOTION TO
WITHDRAW COMPLAINT AND DISMISS CASE**


On July 6, 2020, Nzinga Hughes filed a motion to withdraw her complaint against the Trails at Dominion Park, Ab-Go Trails at the Dominion Park Propco, LLC, RealPage Utility Management, Inc. (f/k/a NWP Services Corporation), and Goldoller Real Estate Investments, and to dismiss this case. Ms. Hughes indicated that an agreement had been reached which has resolved her complaint. No objections were filed.

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.181(f)(2) and (6), an order by an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) dismissing a proceeding based solely on the withdrawal of an application is the final order of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission).¹ Under 16 TAC § 22.181(g)(5), an order granting a request to withdraw an application must state whether the dismissal is with or without prejudice. In accordance with 16 TAC § 22.181(g)(1), a party that initiated a proceeding may withdraw its application without prejudice to refile at any time before that party has presented its direct case. Ms. Hughes has not yet presented her direct case at a hearing on the merits in this proceeding. In this situation, 16 TAC § 22.281(f)(2) authorizes the ALJ to issue an order dismissing this proceeding without preparing a proposal for decision.

¹ Ms. Hughes' complaint constitutes an "application" under 16 TAC § 22.2(6).

Accordingly, Ms. Hughes' motion to withdraw her complaint and to dismiss this case is **GRANTED**, and this case is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings and the Commission, pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.181(f)(2) and (6), (g)(1) and (5).
