COMMISSION STAFF'S FINAL RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Final Recommendation and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On June 14, 2018, the City of Tomball (Tomball) and Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (Aqua) filed an application under the Texas Water Code § 13.248 and Texas Administrative Code § 24.117 (TAC) for approval of a service area contract and to amend their water certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Harris County.

The Applicants, by mutual agreement, seek approval and enforcement of a contract designating CCN service areas. The contract involves a transfer of 353 acres from Aqua's water CCN No. 13203 to Tomball's water CCN No. 13257 and a transfer of 356 acres from Aqua's sewer CCN No. 21065 to Tomball's sewer CCN No. 21103. There is no transfer of assets or facilities between the applicants.

Order No. 2, issued on July 18, 2018, established a deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation, if no hearing was requested, by September 26, 2018. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION

As detailed in the attached memorandum from Debbie Reyes in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division (Attachment A), Staff has reviewed the application and recommends that it be approved. In accordance with this recommendation, the certificates (Attachment B) and maps (Attachment C) that the parties consented to in their filings of September 12, 2018, and

September 17, 2018, are attached. On or before October 4, 2018, the parties will jointly file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully recommends that the Commission approve the application.

On June 14, 2018, Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (Aqua) and City of Tomball, Texas (City) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.248 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.117. The Applicants seek approval of a contract expressing the Applicants' agreement to transfer portions of Aqua's water CCN No. 13203 and sewer CCN No. 21065 service areas to the City's adjacent existing water CCN No. 13257 and sewer CCN No. 21103 service areas.

The Applicant's application includes the transfer of approximately 353 total acres and 0 current customers from Aqua's water CCN No. 13203 to the City's water CCN No. 13257. In addition, the application includes the transfer of approximately 356 acres and 0 current customers from Aqua's sewer CCN No. 21065 to the City's sewer CCN No. 21103.

Notice was not required for this application because there are no affected customers in the area subject to the transfer.

The application meets all of the statutory requirements of TWC Chapter 13 and 16 Tex. Admin. Code Chapter 24 rules and regulations. Staff recommends approval of the application.

Aqua consented on September 17, 2018, and the City consented on September 12, 2018, to the attached map and certificates.

Based on the above information, Staff recommends the Commission do the following:

- Issue an order approving the application;
- Provide the attached map and certificates to the Applicants.

Staff further recommends that the Applicants file certified copies of the CCN map along with a written description of the CCN service areas in the county clerk's office pursuant to TWC §§ 13.257 (r)-(s).




