


Contractors shall take into consideration these tests when bidding the project. All new lines must pass their respective tests so the Utilities Department can recommend approval of the project. It is the responsibility of the contractor to notify the Utilities Department before any testing is performed. The Utilities Inspector must be present to validate the test.

Attached please find a list of requirements that the Utilities Department looks for in the approval process of all plans and specifications. Our intent is to simplify and facilitate our review process.

The above mentioned requirements are in effect as of March 1, 1998 and will apply to all projects on or after this date. All previous projects will not be affected. We appreciate your cooperation on this manner and if you have any questions, please don't hesitate to call Jerry Pinzon, Assistant Utilities Director or Pablo Martinez, Utilities Engineer at 795-2600.

# Water Utilities Department Project Approval Requirements

To expedite and simplify the review process of plans and specifications on all City of Laredo projects, the Utilities Department has created the following list of requirements:

## WATER DISTRIBUTION

### A. Flow Calculations

1. Use 4.3 people per residential lot
2. 130 gallons per day
3. 2.5 peak factor

### B. Construction Drawings

1. Submit two copies of the distribution plans clearly showing all existing and proposed water mains, service taps, water valves, fire hydrants, blow-off hydrants and air release valves.
2. Water lines must be minimum 8" diameter and must loop at all times, when looping is not possible, install a blow-off hydrant at the end of the line (Kupferle Mainguard #78 blow-off hydrant, or approved equal).
3. Dead-end streets with a maximum length of 300 feet can have a 6" diameter main with a blow-off hydrant at the end.
4. All water mains beneath concrete structures (streets, channels, fences, etc) and crossing residential properties must be encased or of Ductile Iron Pipe.
5. Fire hydrants must be placed at street corners and avoid placing in between lots.
6. Use minimum (3) gate valves at every "Cross" connection and (2) gate valve at every "T" connection. Place valves on the direction of the line extension. Gate valves shall be maximum 500 feet apart.
7. Stub-outs must have a gate valve installed at the "T" or "Cross" connection reinforced with a concrete thrust and an M.J. Cap at the end of the line. The pipe must extend outside the street asphalt or any other structure. Use a minimum 10 foot separation between gate valve and the M.J. Cap.
8. Fire sprinkler Systems must extend a separate line from the main for every building with a gate valve and a Backflow Prevention Assembly (Backflow Prevention Assembly must be approved by the Pollution Control Division personnel).

## WASTEWATER COLLECTION

### A Flow Calculations

1. Use 4.3 people per residential lot
2. 100 gallons per day
3. 2.5 peak factor

### B. Construction Plans

1. Submit two copies of the wastewater collection plans clearly showing all existing and proposed wastewater mains, service taps, manholes, clean-outs, force mains, air release valves and lift stations. The plans must include profiles of wastewater mains and force-mains.
2. Wastewater mains must be minimum 8" diameter and with a maximum spacing between manholes of 500 feet.
3. Manholes must be used at every change of direction exceeding a 5% deflection and change in elevation of the wastewater main.
4. Use clean-outs at every end of a main line.
5. Use the following criteria in designing the wastewater collection system:

Size of Pipe In Inches.	Minimum Slope In Percent	Maximum Slope In Percent
6	0.50	8.00
8	0.33	5.28
10	0.25	4.00
12	0.20	3.20
15	0.15	2.40
18	0.11	1.76
21	0.09	1.44

If the line exceeds the maximum slope then use a drop manhole.

6. Use fiber-glass manholes at all non-traffic areas. Place manholes at the street corners and avoid placing manholes in front of properties, if that is not possible, then place them between lots and use single service taps for the two properties.
7. All wastewater mains crossing residential properties must have a manhole installed at both ends of the line.
8. Force mains must be constructed following water pipe specifications (Section C, Part 2).

The Customer Protection Division (CPD) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUC) received your complaint against the City of Laredo on 6/7/2018. In your complaint you mentioned concerns regarding the refusal to provide service to your property. With the information provided, CPD sent the complaint to the City of Laredo with a request to research your complaint and file their response to your concerns. On 7/2/2018, CPD reviewed the documentation provided by you and the City of Laredo in order to ensure the utility had acted consistently with applicable Substantive Rules.

The City of Laredo provided an Interlocal Government Agreement between Webb County and the City, which does not allow for service to be provided to industrial developments outside the city limits with some exceptions, as stated in Section 31-3 (c) of the City of Laredo, TX Code of Ordinance.

Note: The City of Laredo was granted a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN). Because they meet the requirements of the commission to provide continuous and adequate service to every qualified applicant, as set forth in PUC Substantive Rules §24.102 Criteria for Granting or Amending a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity.

Based on the investigation conducted the Customer Protection Division has determined that the City Of Laredo has failed to act consistently with Substantive Rule §24.114 Requirement to Provide Continuous and Adequate Service. Any retail public utility which possesses or is required by law to possess a certificate of convenience and necessity or a person who possesses facilities used to provide utility service must provide continuous and adequate service to every customer and every qualified applicant for service whose primary point of use is within the certificated area. We trust this matter has been clarified to your satisfaction.



In addition of giving a “10 foot Road and Right-of-Way and Public Utility Easement around this property on January 17, 2002 (0.928 Acres, Volume 1360, Page 619, O.P.R.W.C.T.)”, Mr. Manuel Torres gave a 15 foot utility easement on July 11, 2008 (Volume 2628, Pages 12 to 16, O.P.R.W.C.T.) to allow for the installation of a lift station and a force main. Mr. Torres’s intention was to subdivide the original 61.13 acre tract into six 10+ acre lots. He asked for six water services and they were installed. (Attached are pictures taken by David J. Cantu)

Mr. Joaquin Ruperto Torres is the son of Manuel Torres and the person that sold Tract 19 less the easements (59.03 acres) to Jacaman Land LLC.

Jacaman Land LLC went to Webb County Planning Department to replat the property into five tracts, each greater than 10 acres.

Regarding Guidance on Lot Connections

After researching EDAP law and policy, TWDB Staff makes the following guidance on connections for more than one home on a lot in EDAP eligible areas:

1. For homes that were in existence before the contract begins construction, and in an EDAP eligible subdivision (existent before June 1, 1989)
  - If the homes are primary residences, EDAP funds may be used to pay for hook-ups (to include water meters) so long as the specific fund restrictions allow it and the TWDB has not proscribed hookups as an eligible expense in the commitment/grant agreement.
  - EDAP funds may only be used to pay for residential properties. This does not include rental, office, store, or workshop/factory properties.
2. Any homes built after the end of construction are not eligible for EDAP funds (unless specifically agreed to by the TWDB). The model subdivision rules (MSRs) would prevent any of these residences from having more than one house per lot.
3. TWDB requires the applicant and the county they are located in to police who receives hook-ups during construction (applicant) and also the MSRs (the county), once construction has been completed. The applicant is responsible for any abuses of the TWDB hook-up policies.

Keith -

You've requested some guidance on providing water service to lots with multiple homes and whether the model rules apply to an EDAP project area

In general, the model subdivision rules do not apply to EDAP eligible areas because in order to be eligible the area needed to be created prior to the date that the model rules were effective. There may well be lots in an EDAP eligible area that have multiple houses. It has been the policy of the TWDB that all houses in an EDAP-eligible area at the time of construction are eligible for connection to the EDAP funded system and the costs of connection, such as meters, are eligible expenses. Even commercial business in the EDAP eligible area that were identified during facility planning can connect to an EDAP project, though connection costs are not an EDAP eligible cost

I spoke to Joel Smith to try to get some additional background information. There has been some concern expressed about attempted profiteering by residents by splitting lots or just erecting additional houses and getting the meters and service for free. Obviously this is not the intent of the program. The policy of the TWDB has been to allow connection of homes that were constructed after the preparation of the facility plan. However, if the owner of a lot in an EDAP eligible area creates a two or more lots for residential purposes by sale or other conveyance (including rental), then it is a subdivision and that lot owner has to comply with the model subdivision rules and appropriate regulations. Further, the only structures the TWDB would require to be connected to the EDAP funded system are the structures that are identified in the facility plan. If a City (for whatever policy reason that it deems appropriate) seeks to limit the number of additional structures that get connected, that may be a prerogative available to them.

I hope this adequately addresses the issue you have. Of course, feel free to contact me with any other questions or comments.

Jonathan -

I need some guidance on providing water service to lots with multiple homes. My recommendation is that all of the homes need to be hooked up and that this action is not in violation of the MSRs since the subdivision in question existed prior to 1989 (hence to EDAP eligibility). Others feel that the MSRs will only allow one meter per lot regardless of the number of homes and existence prior to 1989. They also cite the fact that ORCA only funds one meter per lot and will not fund multiple meters for multiple homes.

Any guidance you can provide would be greatly appreciated.

## Recovery of Economically Distressed Area Impact Fees

- (a) It is the intent of the legislature that a private developer not unduly benefit from the expenditure by the state of public funds on infrastructure for public benefit.
- (b) In this section:
- (1) "Capital improvement costs" includes:
- (A) the construction contract price;
  - (B) surveying and engineering fees;
  - (C) land acquisition costs, including land purchases, court awards and costs, attorneys fees, and expert witness fees;
  - (D) fees actually paid or contracted to be paid to an independent, qualified engineer or financial consultant who is:
    - (i) preparing or updating the capital improvements plan; and
    - (ii) not an employee of the subdivision; and
  - (E) projected interest charges and other finance costs that are used for the payment of principal and interest on bonds, notes, or other obligations issued by or on behalf of the political subdivision to finance the capital improvements plan and that are not used to reimburse bond funds expended for facilities that are not identified in the capital

- (2) an economically distressed area, as defined by Section 16.341.
- (d) The provider of water or wastewater utility service to an economically distressed area may recover from a developer or owner of an undeveloped lot economically distressed areas program impact fees as provided by rules adopted by the board.

As you know, CID 11: SH 359 Water and Wastewater Hook-ups was completed on February 22, 2012. This completes the project scope for the Joint Colonias Project, SH 359 and Mines Road, TWDB # 10045. At this time, it is appropriate to consider the capacity buy-in allocations for water and wastewater contained in the funding for grants G13600 (wastewater) and G13500 & G13700 (water).

The budgeted amount for water treatment capacity buy-in is \$121,817 and for wastewater treatment capacity buy-in is \$739,338. These amounts were to provide for the flows from 945 water and wastewater connections per the approved Facility Engineering Plan (FEP). These are the amounts which would apply, if the City of Laredo (City) had completed all the connections. Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) has repeatedly stated that the available funds would be prorated according to the percentage of completed connection versus total connections.

In determining the correct percentage, TWDB staff has looked at three major options. The first method uses TWDB data for total connections and connections completed. The second method uses the City's data for total and completed connections. The third uses the City's completion counts, which are higher than TWDB's, and the FEP overall connections.

You will find a spreadsheet attached to this letter that tabulates the three methods. The TWDB data method relies on data compiled in September 2011 in an internal document using to estimate over-all completion of connections. It was assumed that all connections in the Mines Road area would be completed. Credit was given for the SH 359 connections where the lines had been installed but final connection not made, making the total of connection made for CID 11 141, instead of 126.

The second method uses the City's data obtained from the February 2012 NADBANK Monthly Progress Report (Report) with the exceptions noted on the spreadsheet. The third method uses the 945 connection count from the FEP, which is supposed to represent the number of connections at completion of construction and the City's (higher) connections completed count, to determine the overall percentage completed.

The three methods yield different percentage completions for connections. Method 1 has 572 connections completed out of a total of 835, for a 68.5% completion rate. The second method has a total of 585 connection completed out of a total of 883, which gives a 66.3% completion rate. Method 3 uses the City's figure of 585 connections completed divided by 945 total connections for a 61.9% completion rate.

On March 2, 2012, TWDB staff met and reviewed these calculations. The consensus was that the best completion percentage lay between the Method 1 and Method 2 completion percentage. TWDB staff has determined that 67% of the total project connections were completed.

The amounts of water and wastewater capacity buy-in that the City is eligible to receive from TWDB are calculated by multiplying the capacity buy-in amounts by the percentage completion rate. The calculations are shown below:

Water:





Due to the fact that not all of the Colonia residents applied for service or did not qualify for a utility permit from Webb County, the Texas Water Development Board (TWDB) reduced the funding for water treatment and wastewater treatment capacity buy-in by 33%. Attached is a letter from TWDB dated March 19, 2012, stating that an average of 578.5 Colonia families out of the projected 883 received water and wastewater service (578.5 is an average of the sum of 572 and 585).

The total funding the City of Laredo received from TWDB for "Water and Wastewater Treatment Capacity Buy-In" was \$620,031.60 for 578.5 connections which computes to \$1,071.79 per connection. Since there is no more funding for the Colonias, we will have to charge that amount as water and wastewater connection fees.



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

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
