## ORDER NO. 2 ADDRESSING SUFFICIENCY OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of MSEC Enterprises, Inc. to amend a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete under Texas Water Code Ann. § 13.244 and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.105. The ALJ requires MSEC to provide notice as detailed in the memorandum filed BY Commission Staff on September 27, 2018.

The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for MSEC to file with the Commission signed affidavits affirming that the notice was issued by mail and publication, along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	November 12, 2018
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of MSEC filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
