ORDER NO. 4
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of MSEC Enterprises, Inc. to amend a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. On November 9, 2018, MSEC filed signed affidavits affirming that the notice was issued by mail and publication, along with a copy of the notice and map was sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation. On November 16, 2018, MSEC filed a revised affidavit of proof of notice.

The ALJ finds notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to applicant for review and consent	January 11, 2019
Deadline for applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	January 25, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation on the application	February 1, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	February 8, 2019
