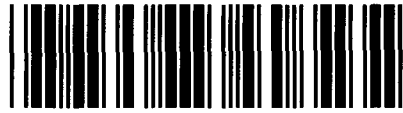

**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT;
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation filed on July 26, 2018, on the administrative completeness of the application filed by MSEC Enterprises, Inc. Commission Staff recommends that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the application deficient and provide MSEC Enterprises, Inc. an opportunity to cure the deficiencies provided in the recommendation.


The ALJ finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider applications filed until it makes a determination of administrative completeness; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before August 27, 2018, MSEC Enterprises, Inc. shall supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. MSEC Enterprises, Inc. shall not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before September 27, 2018, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
