**ORDER NO. 2
ADDRESSING SUFFICIENCY OF APPLICATION AND NOTICE
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the application of the City of Celina to amend a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity in Collin County. On May 23, 2018, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice of the City of Celina. Commission Staff recommended the administrative law judge find the application administratively complete and require the City of Celina to provide notice, a map with each notice, and file signed affidavits attesting that notice was issued, listing each entity and person to whom notice was issued, along with a copy of the actual notice and map, within 30 days of the date of notice and the last publication date. Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.


The application is administratively complete. The City of Celina must provide notice of the application as described in Commission Staff's recommendation using the included forms. The proposed procedural schedule is adopted as follows:

Deadline for the City of Celina to file with the Commission signed affidavits affirming that the notice was issued by mail and publication, along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	September 17, 2018
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of the City of Celina filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
