**ORDER NO. 4  
APPROVING TRANSACTION TO PROCEED**

This Order addresses J&S Water Company, LLC and Nerro Supply, LLC's application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris, Chambers, and Liberty Counties.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds that the application satisfies Texas Water Code §§ 13.241, 13.246, and 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.227 and 24.239. The ALJ further finds that the transaction proposed in this application may proceed and be completed. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than 30 days after, applicants must file proof that the transaction has been completed and that customer deposits have been properly addressed.<sup>1</sup>

Applicants have 180 days to complete the transaction.<sup>2</sup> If the transaction is not completed within this period, this approval is void, unless the Commission in writing extends the time period for good cause shown.<sup>3</sup> Applicants are advised that the certificate affected by this application will continue to be held by J&S Water until this application is complete in accordance with the Commission's rules and final approval is issued.

In an effort to finalize this case as soon as possible, beginning December 19, 2018, and continuing monthly thereafter, the applicants must file an update regarding the status of the efforts



to conclude the transaction and submit documents evidencing the transaction was completed and customer deposits were properly addressed.

Within 15 days following the filing of the applicants' proof that the transaction has been completed, Commission Staff is required to file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the documents and propose a schedule for the continued processing of this docket.
