**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING NOTICE; AND  
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's August 20, 2018 amended recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the application of Bammel Forest Utility Company and Quadvest, L.P. Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the application administratively complete. The amended recommendation corrected the proposed notice to reflect that customers would be charged Bammel Forest rates as opposed to Quadvest rates.

Commission Staff recommended that the applicants provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described by Commission Staff's pleading and attached memorandum, using the included forms. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.

The ALJ deems the application administratively complete. Applicants must provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner and form described by Commission Staff.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

EVENT	DEADLINE
Deadline for applicants to file signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties	October 4, 2018
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of applicants filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
