COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On July 18, 2018, Bammel Forest Utility Company (Bammel Forest) and Quadvest, L.P. (Quadvest) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for sale, transfer or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County, Texas. Specifically, Quadvest, Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11612, seeks approval to acquire all facilities and to transfer all of the water service area and cancel Bammel Forest's water CCN No. 11597.

On January 25, 2019, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 5, finding proof of sale documentation sufficient and establishing a deadline of February 7, 2019, for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs to Applicants for review and consent. Because Staff requires additional time to provide final maps to Applicants for review, Staff requests that the procedural schedule be extended as set forth below. Staff is authorized to represent that Applicants are unopposed to the extension.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff's request for extension, Staff proposes the following supplemental procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Applicants for review and consent	February 28, 2019
Deadline for Applicants to file signed consent forms with the Commission	March 14, 2019
Deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	March 21, 2019

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order adopting the above proposed procedural schedule.
