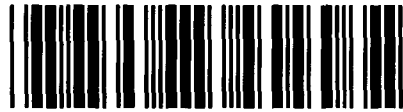

**COMMISSION STAFF'S ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS  
RECOMMENDATION**

COMES NOW the Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this response to Order No. 1, Staff's Administrative Completeness Recommendation. Staff recommends that the application be found administratively complete and that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On July 25, 2018, CS Water Corporation, formerly known as Cedar Shores Water Corporation, (CS Water) filed an application for a name change amendment to its water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11441. CS Water seeks to change the corporate or assumed name on CCN No. 11441 from Cedar Shores Water Corporation to CS Water Corporation. CS Water included with its application a certificate of filing from the Texas Secretary of State effectuating this name change, as well as an affidavit in support of the application.

On July 27, 2018, Order No. 1 was issued requiring Staff to file by August 10, 2018 a recommendation regarding appropriate processing for this docket, whether the application is sufficient, and whether any additional notice is necessary. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**II. APPLICATION SUFFICIENCY RECOMMENDATION**

Staff has reviewed CS Water's application and recommends that it be processed administratively pursuant to the Commission's general authority under Texas Water Code §§ 13.041(a) and 13.241, similar to that of Docket No. 48128.<sup>1</sup> CS Water has provided the

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information and documentation necessary for Staff to review this application on the merits. Therefore, Staff recommends that the application be found sufficient and administratively complete.

### III. NOTICE SUFFICIENCY RECOMMENDATION

Notice in this proceeding is governed by 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.55, which states, “the presiding office may require a party to provide reasonable notice to affected persons.” The Commission submitted notice of this proceeding to be published in the *Texas Register* on August 10, 2018.<sup>2</sup> Staff recommends that such *Texas Register* notice be found reasonable and that no additional notice be required.

### IV. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff’s recommendation that the application be processed administratively and that the application be found sufficient, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline to intervene	September 10, 2018
Deadline for Staff to file a recommendation on final disposition	September 18, 2018
Deadline for CS Water to respond to Staff’s recommendation on final disposition; alternatively, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	September 28, 2018

Staff has conferred with the representative for CS Water and is authorized to represent that CS Water agrees with this proposed procedural schedule.

**V. CONCLUSION**

For the reasons stated above, Staff respectfully recommends that CS Water's application be processed administratively in accordance with the procedure used in Docket No. 48128, that the application be found administratively complete, that no additional notice be required, and that the above proposed procedural schedule be adopted.


