

### COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

**COMES NOW** the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Commission Staff's Recommendation on Final Disposition and would show the following:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On August 2, 2018, the City of Royse City (Royse City) and BHP Water Supply Corporation (BHP), (collectively Applicants) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission (Commission) for approval of a service area contract under Tex. Water Code (TWC) § 13.248, to amend Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) Nos. 10064 held by BHP Water Supply Corporation (BHP), with Royse City's water CCN No. 12827 in Hunt County, Texas. This application is filed pursuant to Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.248. The applicants, by settlement agreement, seek approval to dually certify approximately 210 acres of BHP's current water service area under its CCN No. 10064 with Royse City's water CCN No. 12827. There are no affected customers in the requested area.

On September 5, 2018, Order No. 2 was issued, establishing a deadline of December 3, 2018, for Staff to file a final recommendation on the application. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

### II. RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

As detailed in the attached memorandum from Elizabeth English in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division (Attachment A), Staff has reviewed the application and recommends that it be approved. In accordance with this recommendation, the certificates (Attachment B) and maps (Attachment C) that the parties consented to in their filings of

November 16, 2018 are attached. On or before December 10, 2018, the parties will jointly file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law.

### III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests that the ALJ issue an order consistent with the above recommendation.

On August 2, 2018, City of Royse City (Royse City) and BHP Water Supply Corporation (BHP WSC), (collectively, Applicants) filed an application with the Public Utility Commission (Commission) for approval of a service area contract under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.248, to amend Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) Nos. 12827 (Royse City) and 10064 (BHP WSC) in Hunt County, Texas.

The Applicants filed an agreement designating an area to be served by both Royse City and BHP WSC in accordance with TWC § 13.248. The Applicants requested to dually certify approximately 210 acres of BHP WSC's current water service area under CCN 10064 with Royse City's water CCN 12827. Notice was not required because there are no affected customers in the requested area.

Applicants consented to the attached map and certificates on November 16, 2018.

The application meets all of the statutory requirements of TWC Chapter 13 and 16 Texas Administrative Code Chapter 24 rules and regulations; therefore, Staff recommends approval of the application and the attached final maps and certificates. Staff further recommends that the Applicants file certified copies of the CCN maps along with written descriptions of the CCN service areas in the Hunt County clerk's office pursuant to TWC §§ 13.257 (r)-(s).


