

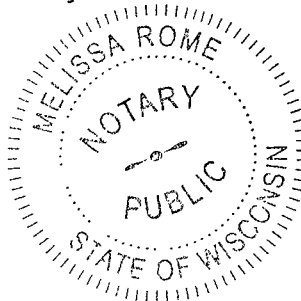

proceeding is (30 days from
the mailing or publication
of notice, whichever occurs
later, unless otherwise pro-
vided by the presiding offi-
cer). You must send a letter
requesting intervention to
the commission which is
received by that date.

If a valid public hearing is
requested, the Commission
will forward the applica-
tion to the State Office of
Administrative Hearings
(SOAH) for a hearing. If
no settlement is reached
and an evidentiary hearing
is held, SOAH will submit
a recommendation to the
Commission for final deci-
sion. An evidentiary hear-
ing is a legal proceeding
similar to a civil trial in state
district court.
