ORDER NO. 5 **GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

This Order addresses Aqua Texas Inc. and Town of Buffalo Gap's status update No. 6 and request for extension to close the transaction, filed on May 20, 2019.

The Town of Buffalo requests an additional 180-day extension, until November 25, 2019, to close the transaction with Aqua. The Town of Buffalo has been working with United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) to obtain funding to purchase the Gap Water System. The Town of Buffalo has been diligently pursuing approvals and easements necessary to comply with USDA's requirements to close the USDA loan to be able to conclude the transaction.

The administrative law judge grants the extension for good cause under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), and extends the 180-day deadline to close the transaction until November 25, 2019.
