COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Recommendation in response to a Notice Finding the Application Incomplete and Deficient and Establishing an Opportunity to Cure and shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On August 9, 2018, Community Water Company (Community) filed for approval of a pass-through rate change to implement its approved purchased water pass-through clause pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §24.21 (renumbered to §24.25 in Project No. 48526, effective October 17, 2018). The purchased water pass-through clause will only pass through costs associated with water purchases from the City of Corsicana. The current pass-through rate is increased from \$6.93 to \$7.22 for customers in the Beaton Lake Estates Subdivision, from \$7.21 to \$7.62 for customers in the Purdon Subdivision and from \$6.70 to \$7.11 for customers in the Retreat Subdivision for water used after November 20, 2018.

On September 12, 2018, a Notice was issued, finding the application to be incomplete and deficient, establishing a deadline of October 5, 2018 for Community to cure the deficiencies, and establishing a deadline of October 19, 2018 for Staff to file a supplemental recommendation on the application and sufficiency of notice, and if the application is sufficient, Commission Staff would provide approved tariff pages to Community by November 2, 2018. This pleading is therefore timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION

As detailed in the attached memorandum from Kathryn Eiland in the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, Staff has reviewed the application and notice and

recommends that both be deemed sufficient. Staff's review also indicates that the application and notice meet the requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.21 (now §24.25). Staff therefore recommends that the application be approved and that the attached tariff pages be provided to Applicant.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully recommends that the application and notice be deemed sufficient, that the application be approved, and that Applicant be provided a copy of the attached tariff sheets.

On August 9, 2018, Community Water Company (Community or Applicant), Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 10534, filed an application to implement a pass-through rate change pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.25, [formerly § 24.21] for an increase in purchased water fees from the City of Corsicana (City) effective October 1, 2018. The Applicant proposes to increase their current pass-through rate from \$6.93 to \$7.22 for customers in the Beaton Lake Estates Subdivision, from \$7.21 to \$7.62 for customers in the Purdon Subdivision and from \$6.70 to \$7.11 for customers in the Retreat Subdivision for water used after November 20, 2018.

Staff reviewed the application and confirmed that Community is correctly reconciling the cost of purchased water using the City's new volume rates compared to cost incurred for purchased water using the City's previous volume rates as ordered in Tariff Control No. 43594 based on total water purchased from July 2014 through June 2018. Staff confirmed that the proposed pass-through rates for the three subdivisions were calculated correctly. Additionally, proper notice has been provided to customers prior to the billing periods in which the new rates take effect.

Based upon review of the information submitted, Staff finds that the application is sufficient and recommends that the Commission:

- 1. Find that the application is sufficient for filing;
- 2. Include the following language in the order, which is carried forward from the order in Tariff Control Number 43594:

"If Community collects an amount as a result of the proposed rate increase or previously approved pass-through increases^a that is higher than the purchased water costs incurred, then Community must refund any amounts collected in excess of the purchased water costs incurred. Refunds shall be made for the same length of time as the proposed rates were collected. Community shall separate the pass-through charges allowed by the pass-through provision from the gallonage charge allowed for general rates in future tariffs

when a general rate increase is requested such that reconciliation of the pass-through revenues with the actual expenses is possible. Community shall also include a true-up provision in a future proposed tariff."

- 3. Approve the pass-through application as filed; and,
- 4. Provide a copy of an approved tariff to the Applicant (attached).
