Re: Tariff Control No. 48584 – *Application of Community Water Company for Approval of a Pass-Through Rate Change*

NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses Community Water Company's application for a pass-through rate change due to an increase in purchased water fees from the City of Corsicana. Community Water requests approval to increase the current pass-through charge of \$6.93 to \$7.22 per \$1,000 gallons for customers in the Beaton Lake Estates subdivision, from \$7.21 to \$7.62 per \$1,000 gallons for customers in the Purdon subdivision and from \$6.70 to \$7.11 per \$1,000 gallons for customers in the Retreat subdivision. The increased fees will be charged for water used after November 20, 2018.

On October 3, 2018, Community Water filed the affidavit of records clerk Annie Bates attesting that Community Water completed notice to customers on September 17, 2018. Community Water provided notice in accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.25(b)(2)(F). The administrative law judge (ALJ) deems the application and notice sufficient.

Community Water correctly reconciled the cost of purchased water using the City of Corsicana's new volume rates compared to costs incurred using the previous volume rates based on total water purchased from July 2014 through June 2018. Community Water calculated the proposed pass-through rates in accordance with 16 TAC § 24.25(b)(2)(A)(vii) and the pass-through provision in its approved tariff.

On November 19, 2018, the ALJ requested the addition of a true-up provision to the tariff, including calculation methodology. On November 27, 2018, Commission Staff responded that Community Water is ineligible for a true-up provision in its current tariff because its pass-through change is combined with its approved gallonage rate.


If Community Water collects an amount as a result of the proposed rate increase or previously approved pass-through increases that is higher than the purchased water costs incurred, then Community Water must refund any amounts collected in excess of the purchased water costs incurred. Refunds must be made for the same length of time as the approved rates were collected.

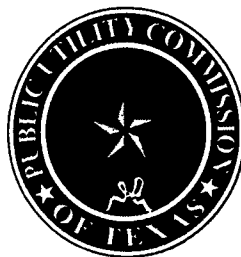
In its next base rate case Community Water must separate the pass-through charges allowed by the pass-through provision from the gallonage charge allowed for general rates such that reconciliation of the pass-through revenues with the actual expenses is possible. Community Water must also include a true-up provision in a future proposed tariff.

The Commission approves Community Water's application and pass-through rates of \$7.22 per 1,000 gallons for the Beaton Lake Estates subdivision, \$7.62 per 1,000 gallons for the Purdon subdivision and \$7.11 per 1,000 gallons for the Retreat subdivision. The tariff pages with the new pass-through rates are attached to this Notice.
