

**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT;
AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the application filed by Raymond Martin to amend High Point Water Supply Corporation's water certificate of convenience and necessity No. 10841 in Rockwall County. On September 10, 2018, Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the application deficient and provide Mr. Martin an opportunity to cure the deficiencies provided in the recommendation.


The ALJ finds the application incomplete and deficient. Under Title 16 of the Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider applications filed until it makes a determination of administrative completeness; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before October 10, 2018, Mr. Martin must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Mr. Martin must not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before November 9, 2018, Commission Staff is required to file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
