**ORDER NO. 1
REQUIRING COMMENTS ON ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLETENESS AND NOTICE;
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

I. Petition

This Order addresses the petition filed on August 17, 2018, by Stoecker Corporation, for expedited release of 322.440 acres of land within the Town of Cut and Shoot's (Cut and Shoot) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 11615 in Montgomery County.

II. Requiring Comments on Administrative Completeness of the Petition and Notice

By September 17, 2018, Commission Staff will file comments on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice.

Commission Staff should also address whether the style of this case should be revised to reflect that Cut and Shoot is an incorporated city.

Notice of this petition will be published in the *Texas Register*. A copy of the notice filed with the *Texas Register* will be provided to Cut and Shoot at their address of record:

Cut and Shoot must file a motion to intervene by September 17, 2018, in order to participate as a party in this proceeding.¹

III. Establishing Procedural Schedule

The following procedural schedule applies to this proceeding:

Publication of <i>Texas Register</i> notice	August 31, 2018
Commission Staff's comments on administrative completeness and notice	September 17, 2018
Deadline for Cut and Shoot and other affected persons to file a written protest or motion to intervene and file comments on the petition	September 17, 2018

Additional deadlines will be established after the petition is deemed administratively complete.

IV. Filing Requirements

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission filing clerk under 16 TAC § 22.71. A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as provided in 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange, <http://interchange.puc.texas.gov>.

All parties will provide their current addresses, telephone number, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party must provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone and information, if such information changes. The telephone number will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.


V. Ex Parte Communications
