PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR A PROPOSED TRANSMISSION LINE

Notice is given to the public of an application filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (commission) on September 12, 2018, for an amendment to a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) for a proposed transmission line in Brazoria, Matagorda, and Wharton Counties.

Docket Style and Number: Application of CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC to Amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for a 345-kV Transmission Line in Brazoria, Matagorda, and Wharton Counties, Docket Number 48629.

The Application: CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (CEHE) filed an application for approval to construct a new 345-kilovolt (kV) double-circuit transmission line located in Brazoria, Matagorda, and Wharton Counties. The new transmission line will connect Bailey substation in Wharton County and Jones Creek substation in Brazoria County. The transmission line will be double-circuit lattice steel towers within a typical right-of-way approximately 100 feet wide. CEHE presented 30 alternative routes with miles of right-of-way ranging from approximately 53.9 to 84.3 miles. The estimated costs for the project range from approximately \$481,720,000 to \$695,201,000, depending on the route selected by the Commission. The Commission may approve any of the routes or route segments presented in the application.
