1. Route GC Bisects Hickory Bayou Ranch which owns two parcels of Hickory Bayou Ranch under the names Hickory Bayou Ranch and JPF leasing.
- ~~2. Route GD, GC and GE destroys Hickory Bayou and JPF leasing historical sight lines.~~
3. Route GD, GC and GE will harm environmentally sensitive rangeland, pasture and wetlands.
4. Local wildlife will be disrupted by the construction and operation of proposed GD, GC and GE.
5. The transmission lines fail to meet greater good criteria as the power is used for increased energy export markets in Freeport.
6. Fy to GE move through Linnville Bayou watershed which is a very environmentally sensitive area.
7. Fy to GE is prime hunting ground which would be drastically impaired by highline construction and operation.
8. Ss Squared Ranch, LLC. – Route GC encroaches Linnville Bayou and nearby waterways. This area is now prone to high water and flooding due to the construction of a rail-line into the P66 Refinery which dams up the normal overflow of watershed towards Old Ocean Swamp. Construction here would be difficult to maintain.
