ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE; AND SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE

This Order addresses the application filed by W.E. Vlasek (Vlasek) on August 29, 2018 to change rates. On September 28, 2018, Commission Staff recommended that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the application administratively incomplete and deficient; provide Vlasek an opportunity to cure the deficiencies provided in the recommendation; and suspend the effective date of the proposed rate change until the application is administratively complete.

The ALJ finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. The Commission does not consider applications filed until it makes a determination of administrative completeness; thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

On or before October 26, 2018, Vlasek must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies described by Commission Staff. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. Vlasek should not issue notice until the application is administratively complete.

On or before November 26, 2018, Commission Staff is required to file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.

Under Texas Water Code § 13.1871(e), the effective date of the proposed rate change is suspended until a properly completed application is accepted.
