**AGREED MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND
RESPONSE TO DISCOVERY REQUESTS**

COME NOW, W.E. VLASEK, Applicant, by and through counsel, and the Commission Staff, and hereby file this Agreed Motion to Amend the Procedural Schedule in this case as set forth in SOAH Order No.5 in this case, and in support hereof, the parties would respectfully show the Honorable Administrative Law Judge as follows:

1. On July 31, 2019 the Honorable Administrative Law Judge issued SOAH Order No. 5 in this case that set forth the procedural schedule of these proceedings. In that Order, the Applicant was given until August 15, 2019 to file its direct pre-filed testimony in this case.

2. Due to certain factors, the Applicant needs additional time to file its direct testimony in this case, and the undersigned contacted the Staff Attorney in charge ALEXANDER PETAK, and requested that the Staff agree to an extension of one (1) week as the deadline for the Applicant to file its pre-filed direct testimony in this case. Mr. PETAK discussed the request with the Commission Staff, and it was agreed by the Commission Staff to grant the Applicant an additional one (1) week extension on the date for the filing of the Applicant's direct pre-filed testimony with the condition that the Commission Staff will be granted an extension of one (1) week to file the Staff's direct prefired testimony. Also, the Applicant and the Commission Staff agreed to extend the effective date for the rates by one (1) week.



Based on the agreement of the parties, both the Applicant and the Commission Staff request that the Honorable Administrative Law Judge approve of the agreement of the parties and grant both the Applicant and the Commission Staff an extension of one (1) week for the filing of their respective direct prefired testimony from the dates set forth in SOAH Order No. 5, and approve the extension of the effective




