**ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE;  
REQUIRING NOTICE; AND  
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 8, 2018, recommendation that the administrative law judge (ALJ) find the City of Lucas' application administratively complete and require the City to provide notice as described within the recommendation. Commission Staff also proposed a procedural schedule.

The ALJ finds the application administratively complete and directs the City of Lucas to provide notice of the application as described by Commission Staff in the recommendation. The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for the City to file signed affidavits that the notice was provided, along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties, and published in a newspaper of general circulation	January 4, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of the City filing proof of completed notice
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
