APPLICATION OF THE CITY OF LUCAS TO AMEND A WATER CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY IN COLLIN COUNTY

PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION

OF TEXAS

ORDER NO. 4 FINDING NOTICE DEFICIENT; AND REVISING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the application of the City of Lucas (Lucas) to amend its water certificate of convenience and necessity in Collin County and the deficiencies of the notice.

On January 14, 2019, Lucas submitted an affidavit attesting to the provision of notice to current customers, neighboring utilities and affected parties. The affidavit is insufficient as it did not include the affidavit of notice to current customers, neighboring utilities and affected persons, nor a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties, and the parties for the attached delivery receipts are unknown. Additionally it appears that Lucas did not provide notice to the county judge or neighboring utilities as required in Order No. 3.

The administrative law judge finds the notice deficient and the following revised procedural schedule applies:

Event	Date
Deadline for Lucas to file with the Commission signed affidavits that notice was given along with a copy of the notice sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	February 22, 2019
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	Within 10 days of Lucas filing proof of completed notice with the Commission
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
