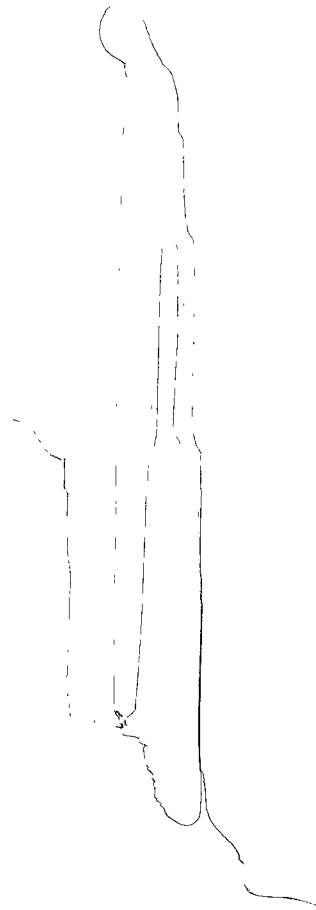

COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Request for Extension, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On September 4, 2018, the City of Lucas (Lucas) filed an application to amend water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) No. 10193 in Collin County. Lucas is requesting an amendment to its water CCN to reflect the actual service territory it currently serves. The requested area would add approximately 3,626 acres, which includes 2,693 current customers and no new customers.

On March 20, 2019, the Commission administrative law judge issued Order No. 5, requiring Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Lucas for review and consent by March 27, 2019. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to prepare and provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable) to Lucas for review and consent. Upon conferring with Staff, Lucas advised that it does not object to the extension.

III. PROPOSED REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Based on the request for extension, Staff proposes the following revised procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for Staff to provide final maps, certificates, and tariffs (if applicable), to Applicant for review and consent if no outstanding issues exist	April 15, 2019
Deadline for Applicant to file signed consent forms with the Commission	April 29, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation on the Application	May 6, 2019
If no hearing is requested, deadline for parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	May 13, 2019

IV. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendation.


